**BS in Professional Flight Admissions Requirements:** This program is for students who already have a private pilot certificate, a commercial pilot certificate, a flight instructor certificate, airplane multiengine land rating, and instrument rating, or who will earn them prior to graduation through concurrent enrollment at a Purdue Global-approved flight school partner. Visit our website for full admissions requirements.

**Certification Exams:** Students are responsible for understanding the requirements of certification exams. The University cannot guarantee students will be eligible to sit for or pass exams.

**Completion Time:** These programs are relatively new, and thus historical data regarding time to completion are not available. Completion time estimates based on a full-time schedule: 3 years, 2 courses per term; 2 years, 3 courses per term. Programs will take longer for part-time students to complete.

**Credit for Prior Learning:** 80 credits, captains; 75 credits, first officers; 45 credits, CFIs who have a multiengine rating. See University Catalog for the Prior Learning policy.
